If you wish to use your Sky remote to operate the TV's basic functions, you will need to program it with the code 2134. If you wish to use your Sky Q remote to operate the TV's basic functions, you will need to program it with the code 4170.

### Sky Remote Code

Note that to use the full functionality of Freeview Play your set must be connected to the internet. Freeview Play brings together live TV viewing with "catch up" TV services such as BBC iPlayer, ITV player, More4 and Demand 5. The Freeview Play Explore app features a carousel of genres to select from when searching for programmes, such as sport, comedy, dramas and soaps, etc. Content is made up from recommendations of the major broadcasters and offers an alternative means of searching.

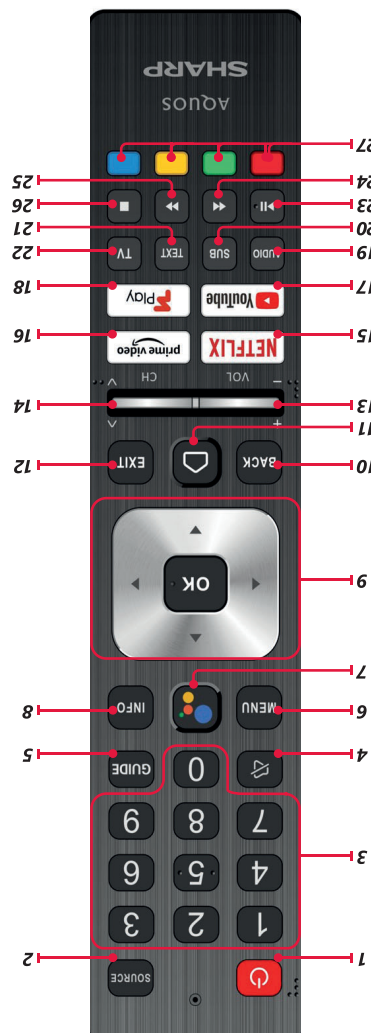
## What is included in the box

To launch the online manual, press the HOME button, select Apps from the Home menu, and select "E-Instruction Manual" from the apps list.

## Online Manual

## Using the remote control

- STANDBY - Switch on the TV when in standby or vice versa.
- SOURCE - To display the input/source menu.
- NUMBER BUTTONS - 0-9 to select a TV channel directly.
- MUTE - Mute the sound or vice versa.
- GUIDE - Opens the 7 day TV guide (Digital TV mode).
- MENU - Displays LIVE TV menu.
- GOOGLE ASSISTANT - Use your voice to access entertainment, control smart devices, obtain answers on screen, and more.
- INFO - Press once for programme information. Press again to view detailed information.
- ▲/▼/▶/◀/OK - Allows you to navigate the on-screen menu and adjust settings to your preference.
- BACK - Step back in the menu.
- HOME - Displays the TV's Home Menu
- EXIT - Exits all menus.
- VOL (+/-) - Tilt to increase/decrease the sound level in the sequence.
- CH (+/-) - Tilt to switch to the next/previous channel in the that line.
- COLOUR BUTTONS - Execute corresponding function at that time.
- - Stop playback.
- ▶▶ - Play in fast forward mode.
- ◀◀ - Play in fast reverse mode.
- ⏸ - Play/Pause media.
- TV - Switches the TV to the last watched input.
- TEXT - Turns teletext on/off.
- SUB - Turns on/off subtitles at the bottom of the screen.
- GOOGLE ASSISTANT - Use your voice to access entertainment, control smart devices, obtain answers on screen, and more.
- MENU - Displays LIVE TV menu.
- AUDIO - Opens the audio track menu, available in the UK.
- FREEVIEW PLAY - Access the Freeview Play service. Only available in the UK.
- YOUTUBE - Access the YouTube App.
- PRIME VIDEO - Access the Prime Video App.
- NETFLIX - Access the YouTube App.




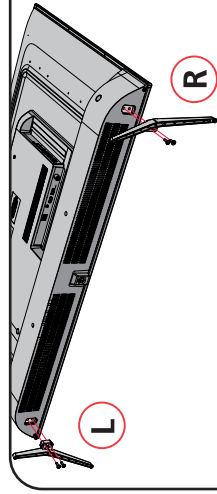
# Setting up the TV set for the first time

## 1 Fitting the stand

The TV panel must be facing downwards. For the stand installation, there is one type of screw provided as shown below.

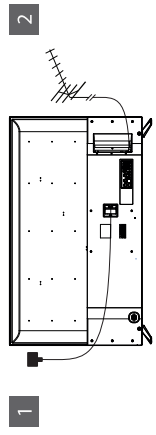
Note: To complete the stand installation you will require a cross head screw driver.

**4 x**  Used for attaching the stand to the TV set (fig.2)

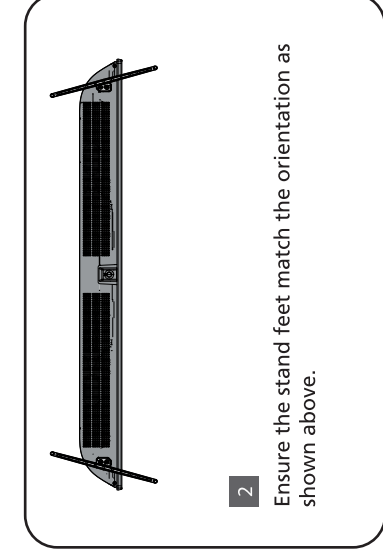
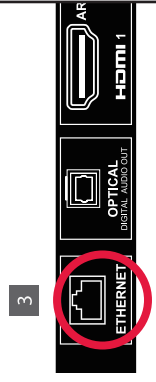


**1** Place the TV set on a flat and clean surface with the panel facing downwards to avoid damage.

## 2 Connecting your set

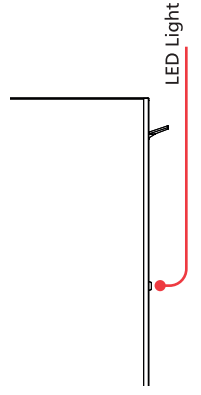


- 1 Connect the TV to your power socket.
- 2 If you wish to use the TV to receive Freeview/Saorview channels, connect the RF input from the TV to your outdoor Digital TV aerial. If you do not wish to receive Freeview/Saorview, skip this step.
- 3 Connect to the internet. Ethernet provides the most stable connection.



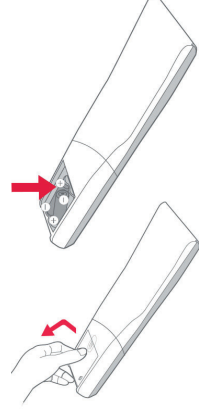
**2** Ensure the stand feet match the orientation as shown above.

## 3 Powering On the TV



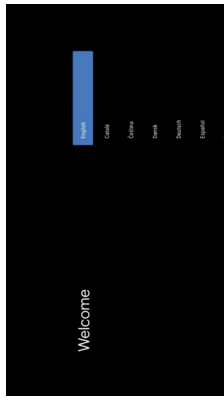
Switch on the television by pressing the on/off button on the bottom of the LED light.

### Remote Control: Installing Batteries



Insert the batteries supplied into the remote controls and press the standby button to power on the TV.

## 4 First time installation



When the set first turns on, it will ask you to select your preferred on-screen display language. This will change the language in which the menus and associated information is displayed in.

**Basic installation steps are shown below. These may vary slightly depending on your model. Due to Android software updates, the look and feel of the TV start up procedure and subsequent menus can be subject to change.**




### Android Phone users


During the set-up process, you will be prompted to sign-in to your Google account using your pre-installed "Google" app. This set up process will depend upon which model TV you are setting up. Please ensure you have your account details to hand.

## 5 Pairing the remote

If during the first time installation process the remote was not paired or skipped, then follow the process below to pair your remote with the television.

- 1 Turn the set on.
- 2 Press the  button on the remote control.
- 3 The pairing screen will appear on the TV.
- 4 Now press and hold the "Left" and "Home" buttons on the remote simultaneously (highlighted).



- 5 The LED indicator on the remote control will start to flash.
  - 6 Select the detected remote control shown on the screen and press OK.
  - 7 Once paired the pairing screen will disappear.
- This process will only need to be carried out if the remote is not paired. Once paired, when the  button is pressed it will open the Google Assistant screen on the set and activate voice functionality.

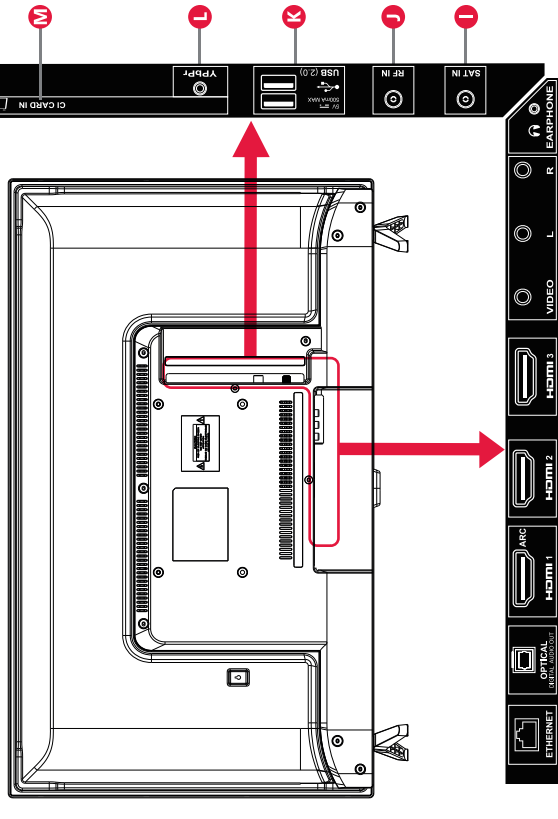
## Wall Mounting the TV

- 1 Remove the four screws that are supplied in the wall mounting holes.
- 2 The wall mount can now be easily attached to the mounting holes on the rear of the TV.
- 3 Install the wall mounting bracket to the television as advised by the bracket manufacturer.
